2. Purpose

The purpose of this document is for **TransPerfect** to disseminate information to end-users (internal and clients) prior to a system release and detail the new features and important changes. Trial Interactive's products deliver a wide range of benefits to any organization looking to leverage new efficiencies and opportunities in their Trial Master File, clinical trial management, content management, and eLearning:

6. Release Overview

A. STUDY AND SITES MODULE FOR SITE TRAINING

GI-950 - GlobalLearn v2.5 is a minor release to our Learning Management System (LMS), specifically designed to streamline, centralize, and scale training processes for study-based organizations. GlobalLearn v2.5 allows training administrators and study teams to manage study and site-specific training better.

Key Features and Enhancements

1. Centralized Study Profile Management

- Unified Data Access: GlobalLearn 2.5 introduces the Study Profile, a centralized hub for managing study-specific details, including Study Name, Study Number, Study Owner, and Description.
- Integrated Room Configuration: For studies with integrated rooms, this feature allows admins to link study profiles to specific rooms, facilitating seamless content delivery.
- Customizable Filtering Options: Quickly locate and organize studies by name, owner, or business unit for faster access and streamlined management.

2. Site Training Enhanced Enrollment and Assignment Process

- Role-Based Training Assignments: Courses and learning plans can now be assigned based on site roles, automating enrollment based on predefined study requirements.
- Differentiated Course Access: Site-related courses are configured specifically for study
 use, allowing only eligible roles to access them. This new workflow keeps the enrollment
 process focused and organized, enhancing user experience.
- Progress Preservation Options: Admins can decide how to handle ongoing training for users affected by changes. Options include keeping them enrolled or unenrolling and removing their progress data, depending on operational needs.

3. Site Training Module - Optimized for Scalability

- Site and Personnel Management: Each study profile can be linked to specific sites and site roles. Adding or removing personnel from a site automatically updates training assignments, saving time and reducing errors.
- Training Path Customization: Courses and learning plans are mapped to study roles, allowing organizations to create study-specific curricula that align with various roles across different sites.
- Enhanced Site Role Management: Site personnel can hold multiple roles within a site, with each role dictating their assigned training curriculum. This feature enables nuanced control over individual learning paths.

4. Site Training Course Enablement

Site-Specific Training Designation:

i. Administrators can mark certain courses as "Site Training Courses" during the course creation process. This designation makes the courses available specifically within the Site Training Module, ensuring that they are directly tied to specific studies and site personnel roles, and they are not open for general enrollment.



ii. Once enabled as a Site Training Course, the course enrollment and progress tracking are managed within the Study Profile module, aligning all training with study-specific requirements.

Role-Based Enrollment:

i. Targeted Training by Role: By setting a course as a Site Training Course, admins can further specify which site roles (e.g., Principal Investigator, Coordinator) the course is intended for. This feature helps in filtering and assigning relevant courses to the right personnel, supporting role-based learning paths that match study protocols. When a site role is assigned to personnel at a study site, they are automatically enrolled in the relevant Site Training Courses. This reduces the manual effort of assigning courses individually and ensures that all site personnel receive the training necessary for their roles within each study.

Visibility and Filtering in Study Profiles:

- i. Site Training Courses enabled for a particular study are easily visible within the Study Profile, creating a clear and organized view of all training requirements for that study. Admins can filter by study or site role to see which courses are associated with each study, enabling quick updates and adjustments as needed
- ii. A dedicated column on the Course Management Page shows the associated study for each course, simplifying the identification and management of training needs for multi-study organizations.
- 5. Managing Site Training Course Enrollment: Enrollment Status is controlled at the Site Level, allowing administrators to manage when and how training is rolled out to personnel at specific sites within a study. This site-based control provides greater flexibility and precision in handling enrollment notifications and course access across different locations, especially useful in multi-site studies where training.

B. ENHANCED STUDY OWNER ROLE

GL-1035 - In this release, the Study Owner role is enhanced with additional permissions and streamlined access to essential Studies and Sites.

What's New for Study Owners?

- Flexible Role Assignment: Grant the Study Owner role to any user in GlobalLearn.
- Enhanced Study Profile Management: Seamlessly add sites, coordinators, and personnel, and assign training within the study profile.
- Complete Site Management: Effortlessly oversee Site Coordinators and personnel.
- Unlimited Learning Access: View all courses and learning plans associated with studies, no matter who created them.
- Certificate Management: Easily view, re-generate, and resend certificates for site personnel.

This release empowers Study Owners with additional permissions to manage Studies and Sites.



C. AUTO CC CUSTOMIZATION FOR CERTIFICATE SHARING

GL-1036 - The Auto CC feature in GlobalLearn 2.5 allows administrators to automatically include specific recipients on certificate emails whenever a user completes a course. This automation ensures that critical training completion records are promptly sent to relevant stakeholders or document management systems without manual intervention.

Key Benefits of Auto CC:

- 1. **Enhanced Compliance and Record-Keeping:** Auto CC ensures that completed certificates are immediately shared with stakeholders who need them, such as study records managers, quality control teams, or external systems (e.g., eTMF). This feature reduces the risk of missed documentation and supports robust compliance practices.
- 2. **Streamlined Documentation Workflow:** For organizations that require certificates to be stored in multiple locations (e.g., both the LMS and an external system), Auto CC automates the forwarding process, eliminating manual steps and potential errors.
- 3. **Non-TI eTMF Integration:** For customers using non-TI eTMF systems, Auto CC can automatically send certificates to designated email addresses within those systems, supporting seamless integration between the LMS and eTMF platforms.


